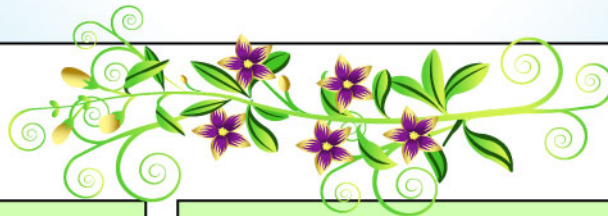


# Compound Adjectives
