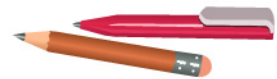


# Pronouns Of Agreement

## "So","Too","Either","Neither"



Positive Agreement	Negative Agreement
He can dance. <b>So</b> can I. I can, <b>too</b> .	He can't dance. <b>Neither</b> can I. I can't <b>either</b> .
He travelled in Asia. <b>So</b> did she. She did, <b>too</b> .	He didn't travel in Asia. <b>Neither</b> did she. She didn't <b>either</b> .
He is smart. <b>So</b> are you. You are, <b>too</b> .	He isn't smart. <b>Neither</b> are you. You aren't <b>either</b> .
He hates carrots. <b>So</b> do they. They do, <b>too</b> .	He doesn't hate carrots. <b>Neither</b> do they. They don't <b>either</b> .
He should work hard. <b>So</b> should I. I should, <b>too</b> .	He shouldn't work hard. <b>Neither</b> should I. I shouldn't <b>either</b> .
